

Challenge: Super Sheffielders!

We all know Sheffield is a great place to live, but did you know there are LOADS of people from Sheffield who have done extraordinary things? From sportsmen and women, to artists, musicians, engineers, scientists, chefs and even a Space Woman! So, here's a challenge to help you to research about some famous Sheffield folk and then tell someone else about them.

You will need:

- Paper, pencil
- Books, the internet or another way to find out about a famous Sheffield person
- Camera (optional)

Step 1: Start researching! You might be able to look in books about Sheffield or ask adults for their knowledge too. Perhaps even do some research on the internet. Come up with a list of famous Sheffield people and make a few notes or draw a picture to describe why they are or were famous. What did they do that was so impressive?

Step 2: Choose one to research a little further. Can you find some basic facts about them, such as the date of their birth (and when they died if they're no longer alive)? Can you find out about their childhood – did they spend it in Sheffield? Which school/s did they go to? And find out a little more about their achievement/s. How did they get into this?

Step 3: Decide how you will present this information to other people – you could design a newspaper article, or even a leaflet. How about a brainstorm sheet with a picture of them in the middle and facts around the edge? You could even write a poem or story of their life. Or, why not create a video to tell the story of the famous Sheffielder's life? Remember to include pictures too!

Step 4: Now it's time to share your knowledge. Ask an adult if you can tell them what you've learned. You could even tell other people in your family, friends, or people at school. Did they already know about this person or were you able to tell them something new?
